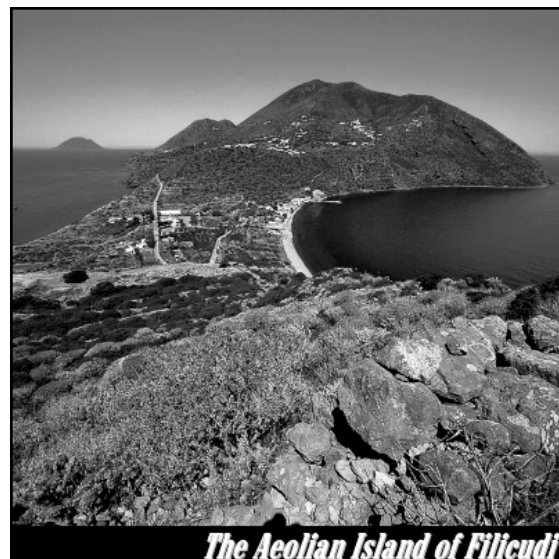

OUR AEOLIAN ISLANDS TOUR ITINERARY:

JUNE 25 – BOSTON-ROME-CATANIA: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our overnight transatlantic Alitalia flight to Catania (*via Rome*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight.

JUNE 26 – CATANIA-MILAZZO-LIPARI: "*Benvenuti in Italia!*" Arrival at the airport in Catania where we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist with our transfer. Board our private motorcoach for the short drive north to Milazzo, where we will board the ferry to Lipari. Arriving at the pier in Lipari Harbor, we will board our minibus for transfer to the *Hotel Arciduca* (or similar) for check-in. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

JUNE 27 – LIPARI: Breakfast at our hotel. Full-day at leisure on Lipari to explore the island on our own. Lunch is on our own today. Points of interest in and around the town of Lipari include the reconstructed Norman church, the fine Archaeological Museum and the truly interesting Archaeological Park. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JUNE 28 – VULCANO: Breakfast at our hotel. enjoy a brisk morning ferry ride to the island of Vulcano for a full-day at leisure to explore this rugged Tyrrhenian outcrop on our own. Lunch is on our own. Return to our hotel on Lipari for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

JUNE 29 - LIPARI: Breakfast at our hotel. Half-day morning guided tour of many of the most famous and historic landmarks that beautiful Lipari has to offer, including a tour of Lipari's wonderful Archaeological Museum. Lunch is on our own. The afternoon is free to continue exploring the island on our own, shopping or just relaxing. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JUNE 30 – LIPARI: Breakfast at our hotel. Full-day at leisure on Lipari for independent sightseeing, shopping or just relaxing. Lunch is on our own today. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JULY 1 – SALINA: Breakfast at our hotel. Board the morning ferry to another of the beautiful Aeolian Islands – Salina! Arriving in the port of Rinella, we will board our private minibus for an island guided sightseeing tour, including the scenic viewpoint of Pollara (*which is prominent in the well-known Italian film "Il Positano"*). Lunch is on our own. We will also have some free time before winding-up today's excursion at the port of Santa Marina where we will board the ferry for the return trip to Lipari. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JULY 2 – LIPARI-FILICUDI: Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will board the ferry for a refreshing morning cruise to the Aeolian Island of Filicudi! Upon arrival on Filicudi, we will check-in at the *Filicudi Hotel Phenicusa* (or similar). Lunch is on our own today. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JULY 3 – FILICUDI: Breakfast at our hotel. Free day to explore Filicudi on our own. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JULY 4 – FILICUDI-MILAZZO-GIARDINI NAXOS: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will board the ferry for Milazzo where we will board our motorcoach for the short trip to Funari to visit the local ceramic to experience the art of making Italian ceramics. Stop along our route for lunch (*on our own*) and then head south to the lovely resort of Giardini Naxos (*adjacent to Taormina*) for check-in at the *Hotel Caesar Palace* (or similar). Our hotel is just a short walk from the beach and has a beautiful pool and patio area. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure the local atmosphere. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

JULY 5 – TAORMINA: Breakfast at our hotel. Travel the short distance to Taormina for a guided walking tour of the city center and winding-up with a tour of the famous Greco-Roman Theater – the show piece of Taormina! Lunch on our own. The afternoon is at leisure for independent sightseeing in the Taormina-area, do some shopping-and-browsing, or relax at one of the excellent nearby beaches. Return to our hotel in Giardini Naxos for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

JULY 6 – CATANIA-VINTNER'S LUNCH-MOUNT ETNA: Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will enjoy a half-day tour of beautiful Catania, including St. Agatha's Cathedral and the open air market. Around noon we will stop at a local eatery for a wonderful Vintner's Lunch including a wine tasting. Our afternoon's excursion will take us halfway up Mount Etna, the largest volcano in all of Europe. This active volcano affords a fascinating sightseeing tour. The topography and fauna will change dramatically as we ascend the mountain for a spectacular view of Taormina and surrounding Sicily. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

JULY 7 – CATANIA-ROME-BOSTON: Following breakfast and hotel check-out, transfer to the airport in Catania to board our return Alitalia flight to Boston (*via Rome*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight. (BB)
